

Your Transcendence® Bath Furniture will retain its beauty for a lifetime. Review these recommendations for routine care and cleaning of your Transcendence® product.

Care & Maintenance: Furniture Cabinets and Consoles

- Dust regularly using a clean, soft cloth.
- Occasionally clean with a wood cleaner, such as a lemon oil polish. Do not use silicone-based cleaners or wax polishers. Silicone-based cleaners can harm the cabinet's finish. The extended use of wax polishes can result in a wax film buildup. Any cleaner or liquid product should be removed immediately from the wood surfaces.
- Use a damp cloth when cleaning normal household spills. After wiping thoroughly, dry the surface with a cotton cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent with warm water and dry the surface immediately.
- Never allow liquids of any kind to remain on the furniture surface. Avoid excessive moisture. Absorption of liquids can cause wood to warp.
- Never use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads or powdered cleansers.
- Do not place in direct sunlight or exposure to open windows.
- Avoid extreme changes in temperature. Keep away from heaters, radiators, or air conditioning units.

Care & Maintenance: Cabinet Hardware

- Periodically use mild soap and warm water to clean the door/drawer knobs and pulls. Thoroughly dry all joints and surfaces with a clean, soft cloth.
- Buff hardware with a clean, soft cloth.
- Many brass and silver polishes contain harsh chemicals that can damage the hardware's surface. These polishes are not recommended.

Care & Maintenance: Mirrors and Glass Panel Inserts

- Apply glass cleaner onto a cloth instead of directly onto the mirror or glass panel. It should not be allowed to run or drip onto the wood frame. Ammonia found in glass cleaners will damage the furniture surface.

Care & Maintenance: Natural Stone Vanity Top

- Wipe off anything spilled on the stone top immediately.
- Occasionally wash surface with lukewarm water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.
- For a more thorough cleaning, wash with a mild detergent solution, rinse, and wipe dry thoroughly. Do not use vinegar, lemon juice, or other cleaners containing acids.
- Do not use abrasive dry or soft cleansers.
- Avoid resting hot objects directly on the stone vanity top.

Sealing: Granite and Marble Vanity Tops

- Transolid Granite and Marble Vanity Tops are sealed at the factory. However, to provide extra assurance, we recommend that a protective sealer be applied to the vanity top after installation (available at home improvement stores or from stone dealers) and then again at least once every two years.
- Before applying the sealer, the exposed areas should be clean and dry. Follow the instructions on the sealer container.
